I attended last week's Jefferson City council meeting to see how the vote would go on the proposed traffic signal application to GDOT.
I was very pleased to learn that the City Council voted to approve the application.

I'm well aware that Jefferson is operating on a *very* tight budget and will be for some time. However, this has been a *very dangerous* intersection that has needed a traffic signal for some time. With the huge increase in traffic that will result from the opening of the new Kroger in Feb/Mar '07 at the adjacent Loggins Corners, it is absolutely essential that a new traffic signal be installed on an expedited basis.

At the risk of seeming "overly dramatic", this is a "life or death" situation for the good folks of Jefferson and Jackson County!

I would like to offer you as much pro-active support as I can to make this a reality. This might include pursuing non-traditional funding resources and taking whatever "grass roots" political action y'all feel would be helpful in supporting and prioritizing this project.
